Pre-Travel Health Consultation Worksheet

The Center for Global Education *strongly recommends* a pre-travel health consultation with the CSB Health Services, SJU CentraCare Clinic or your private medical provider before you study abroad. The Center for Global Education is not a travel health expert; therefore, we have compiled the resources below to help you be a safe, healthy and smart traveler. *KEY ITEMS TO KEEP IN MIND...*

- PLAN AHEAD! Medical practitioners' schedules fill fast. Schedule your pre-travel health consultation AT LEAST 6
 WEEKS before you plan to leave the U.S.
- Many vaccines are given in series, often over the course of several weeks, re-enforcing the need to schedule your pre-travel health consultation early.
- Visit the CDC website (www.cdc.gov) to educate yourself regarding your travel destinations.
- Be sure to work with CISI Insurance provided by CSBSJU to make any necessary arrangements for your health while you are abroad.

BEFORE YOUR PRE-TRAVEL HEALTH CONSULATION...

For your health care provider to give you the best information, you need to be prepared with the following information:
