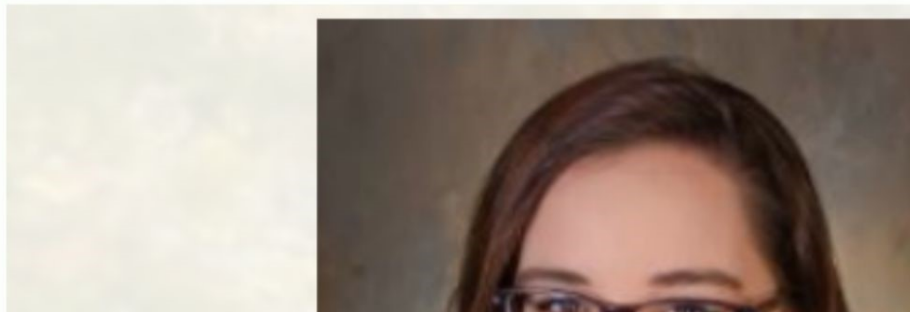

## Renewal Requests

**Renewal requests for 2024-2025 housing accommodations must be submitted to Student Accessibility Services no later than March 6, 2024.**

Requests submitted after March 6, 2024, will be reviewed but may not result in a pre-selection housing offer.

## New Requests

**New requests for 2024-2025 housing accommodations must be submitted to Student Accessibility Services no later than March 12, 2024.**

Requests submitted after March 12, 2024, will be reviewed but may not result in a pre-selection housing offer.

The first step in the housing selection process is to complete the Housing Intent Form on the housing portal.



This lets Residential Life know your 2024-2025 academic year plans and completion is required to participate in all housing selection processes.

## Know Your Housing Classification

### **Housing Classification Descriptions**

<b>Number of Semesters on Campus</b>	<b>Housing Classification</b>
Rising Sophomores - 1 or 2 semesters on campus	CSB - Returning - Not Apartment Eligible
Rising Junior - 3 or 4 semesters on campus	CSB - Returning - Apartment Eligible
Rising Senior - 5 or 6 semesters on campus	CSB - Returning - Seniors Only Selection
Rising SR+ - 7 or more semesters on campus	CSB - Returning 5+ Senior

**What should I do if my housing classification is listed as "New Transfer?"**

**Email CSB Residential Life**

Contact CSB Residential Life. Residential Life will work with you to place you in a “returning” classification status before housing selection. CSB Residential Life may request a copy of unofficial transcripts to assist with the classification process.
