

Information Literacy DEAL Reflection Prompt

INFORMATION LITERACY: Identify, evaluate, and responsibly use information.

Beginner: Students access appropriate information through common search strategies, accurately cite the source, and articulate the value of accurate citation.

Describe:

- In 2-3 sentences describe a project where you used information literacy skills.

Examine:

- What were some of the search strategies that you used?
- How did you determine what were and were not appropriate sources of information?

Analyze Learning:

- In your own words, explain why it is important to accurately cite your sources.

Intermediate: Students locate relevant information using well-designed search strategies, evaluate and use appropriate and multiple resources, and articulate why using information has many ethical and legal implications.

Describe:

- In 2-3 sentences describe a project where you used information literacy skills.

Examine:

- What were the search strategies that you used for your project?

Analyze Learning

- How have your search strategies changed during your time in college?
- What is the value in using multiple resources in research or creative work?
- What are some of the ethical and legal implications of using information and why do they matter?
