COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

MCLT 319-01A: Topics in East Asian Literature & Translation Yuko Shibata

This course introduces entertainment novels, comics and films created by Japanese female writers and directors since the 1970's. Postwar economic development made it possible for young talented women to go into a variety of cultural fields and become successful. We examine how these contemporary female creators have come to terms with issues of gender, sexuality, race, class, and nation as well as how their products have intersected the changing phases of economic conditions. Their works have created new businesses, not only in the Japanese but also in the broader Asian market, by being combined with thriving local entertainment industries, and what these phenomena signify, especially when the images of the West, Asia, the US and Japan are diversely reflected in these works.

THEO 265-01A: Readings in Theology

Discussion of the book *Theological and Scientific Commentary on Darwin's Origin of Species* by Ted Peters (theologian) and Martinez Hewlett (molecular biologist), to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the publication of Charles Darwin's *ON THE ORIGIN OF SPECIES*. All points of view will be respectfully discussed; our aim is to shed light on both the science and the theological controversies which surround Darwin's book. One of our sessions will feature discussion with Ted Peters.
